A. побудительные, просьбы и т.п.

“**Read** the word!”

“Could you **help** me?”

“**Don't be** so absent-minded, please.”

A. to Vo (Infinitive)
A. not to Vo (Infinitive)

She tells us **to read** the word.

She asks **to help** her.

She asks me **not to be** so absent-minded.

1. He says, “*You are* late.” He says that *I am* late.

2. They said, “It is very important for you.”

They said it was very important for us.

1. без вопросительного слова

A. (+ , -- , ?)	if whether	подл. + сказ. + ...
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“Are you a student?”

“ Does she speak English or German?”

“It’s your book, isn’t it?”

She asks if **I am** a student.

She asks if **she speaks** English or German.

She asks if **it is** my book.

2. специальные

A. (+ , -- , ?)	why (вопросительная фраза)	подл. + сказ. + ...
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“How many times **have you seen** the film?” -

She asks *how many times* **I have seen** the film.

“Where **is the nearest bank?**” -

He asks *where* **the nearest bank is**.

“What **did you say?**” –

He wonders *what* **I said**.

3. к подлежащему

A. (+ , -- , ?)	who (what, whose... - подл.) + сказ.
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“Who **has got** a car?”

They ask **who has got** a car.
