<b>Future Simple</b>	<p>Mary <b>will help</b> him next time.  Mary <b>will not help</b> him next time.  <b>Will</b> Mary <b>help</b> him next time?</p>	<p>He <b>will be helped</b> next time.  He <b>will not be helped</b> next time.  <b>Will</b> he <b>be helped</b> next time?</p>
<b>Past Continuous</b>	<p>Mary <b>was helping</b> him when I saw them.  Mary <b>wasn't helping</b> him when I saw them.  <b>Was</b> Mary <b>helping</b> him when you saw them?</p>	<p>He <b>was being helped</b> when I saw him.  He <b>was not being helped</b> when I saw him  <b>Was</b> he <b>being helped</b> when you saw him?</p>
<b>Present Continuous</b>	<p>Mary <b>is helping</b> him right now.  Mary <b>is not helping</b> him right now.  <b>Is</b> Mary <b>helping</b> him right now?</p>	<p>He <b>is being helped</b> right now.  He <b>is not being helped</b> right now.  <b>Is</b> he <b>being helped</b> right now?</p>
<b>Future Continuous</b>	<p>Mary <b>will be helping</b> him when you come.  Mary <b>will not be helping</b> him when you come.  <b>Will</b> Mary <b>be helping</b> him when I come</p>	<p>НЕТ</p>

<b>Past Perfect</b>	Mary <b><i>had helped</i></b> him by the time I saw them. Mary <b><i>had not helped</i></b> him by the time I saw them. <b><i>Had</i></b> Mary <b><i>helped</i></b> him by the time you saw them?	He <b><i>had been helped</i></b> by the time I saw him. He <b><i>had not been helped</i></b> by the time I saw him. <b><i>Had</i></b> he <b><i>been helped</i></b> by the time you saw him?
<b>Present Perfect</b>	Mary <b><i>has</i></b> already <b><i>helped</i></b> him. Mary <b><i>has not helped</i></b> him yet. <b><i>Has</i></b> Mary already <b><i>helped</i></b> him?	He <b><i>has</i></b> just <b><i>been helped</i></b> . He <b><i>has not been helped</i></b> yet. <b><i>Has</i></b> he <b><i>been</i></b> already <b><i>helped</i></b> ?
<b>Future Perfect</b>	Mary <b><i>will have helped</i></b> him by the time you come. Mary <b><i>will not have helped</i></b> him by the time you come. <b><i>Will</i></b> Mary <b><i>have helped</i></b> him by the time I come?	He <b><i>will have been helped</i></b> by the time you come. He <b><i>will not have been helped</i></b> by the time you come. <b><i>Will</i></b> he <b><i>have been helped</i></b> by the time I come?
<b>Past Perfect Continuous</b>	Mary <b><i>had been helping</i></b> him for two hours when I saw them. Mary <b><i>had not been helping</i></b> him for two hours when I saw them. <b><i>Had</i></b> Mary <b><i>been helping</i></b> him for two hours when you saw them?	нет
<b>Present Perfect Continuous</b>	Mary <b><i>has been helping</i></b> him for a long time. Mary <b><i>has not been helping</i></b> him for a long time. <b><i>Has</i></b> Mary <b><i>been helping</i></b> him for a long time?	нет
<b>Future Perfect Continuous</b>	Mary <b><i>will have been helping</i></b> him for five hours when you come. Mary <b><i>will not have been helping</i></b> him for five hours when you come. <b><i>Will</i></b> Mary <b><i>have been helping</i></b> him for five hours when I come?	нет
