3. Gain practical experience using a web 2.0 tool

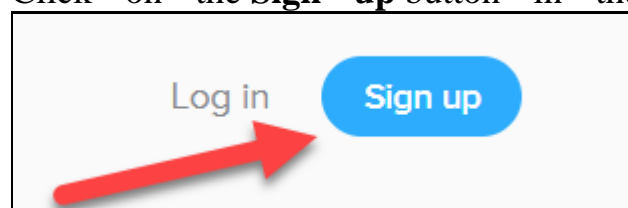
### Assessment

4. Add a picture that describes 3 of the text entries

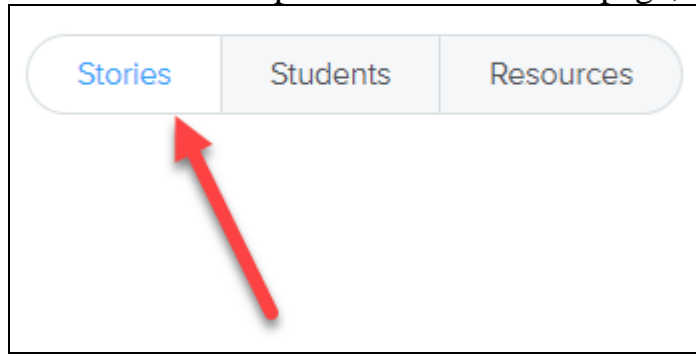
### Task 1: Create an Account at Sutori.com

  1. Click on the **Sign up** button in the upper-right corner

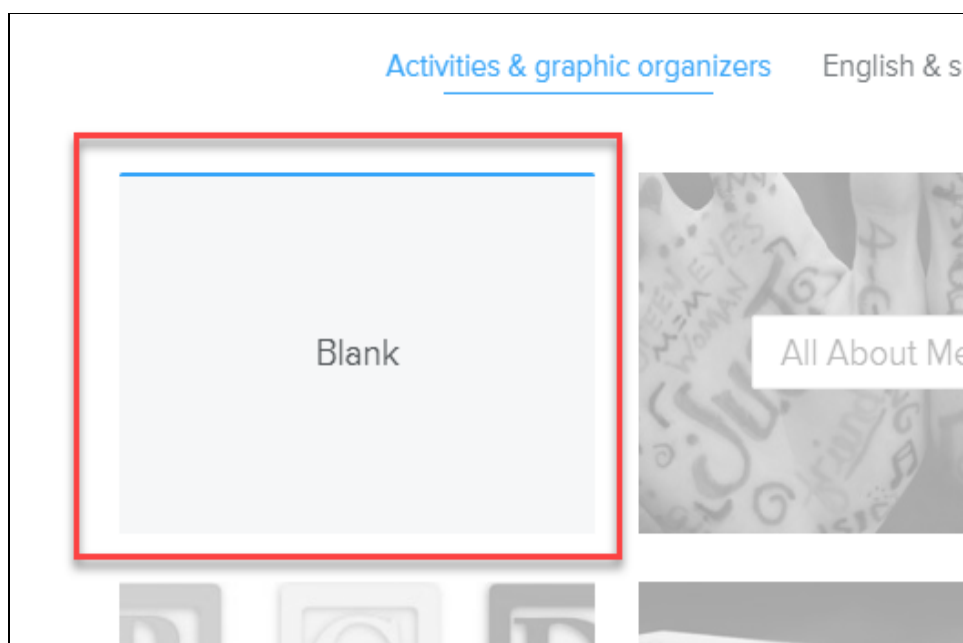
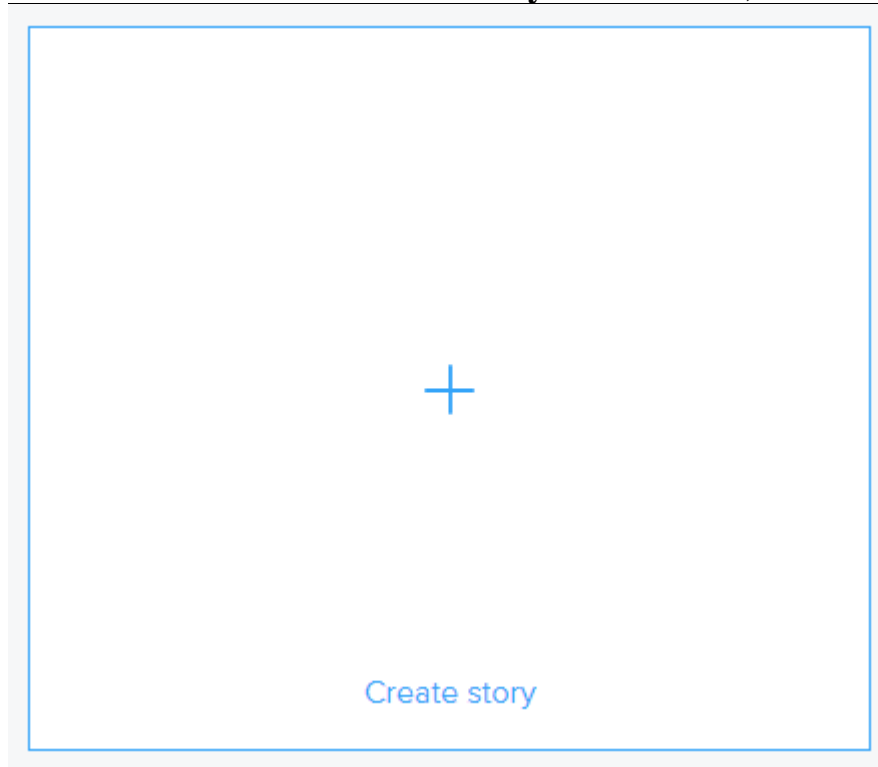


2. Follow the prompts to create your account


2. At the top of the page, click on **Stories**



3. Click on **Create story**. Then, select **Blank**

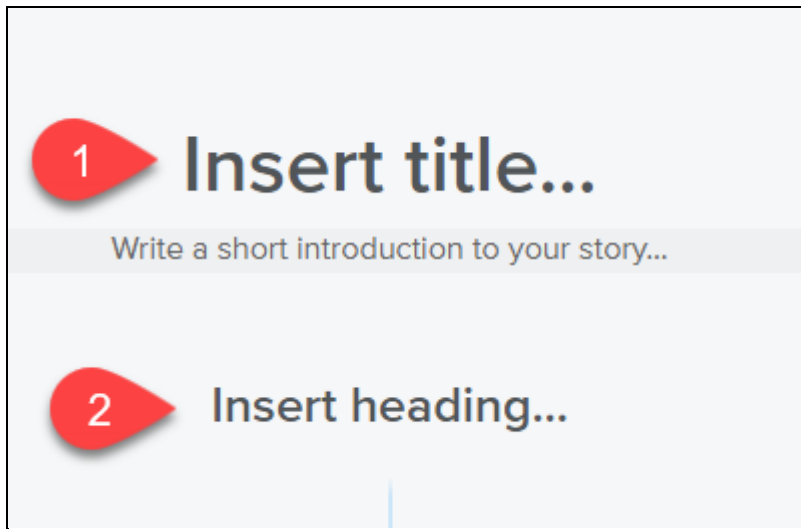


4. You should see a blank presentation



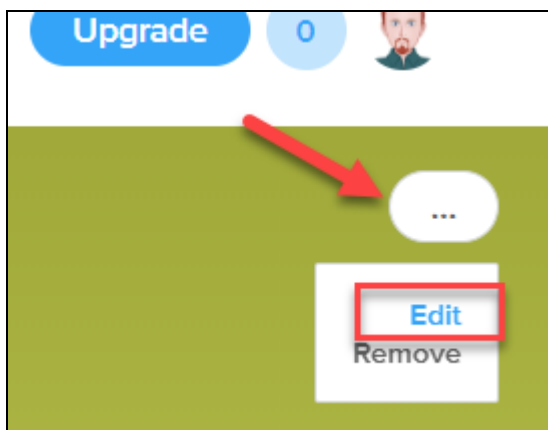
## Task 2: Add Entries to the Timeline


1. Select a topic or theme relating to telecommunications (modern or historical)
  1. **Broad examples:** internet, wire communication, radio transmissions, voice transmissions, events in 1AD-1500AD, 1900-1990;
  2. **Narrow example:** cellular data (2g-4g), DSL/Home internet, satellite communication, WiFi, events in 2010-2012, 2017, etc.
2. Give your timeline a title (Click on Insert title...)
  1. The title should end with: (ICT 2019)
  2. For example: ICT through the ages (ICT 2019)
3. Search the internet and locate technological advances in communication
4. Add a heading that describes your topic
  1. You might use years for a date range: 0 AD - 1500 AD; 1990-1995; 2015
  2. You might use a specific technology: 5G Technologies; Wired communication; Communication advancements,

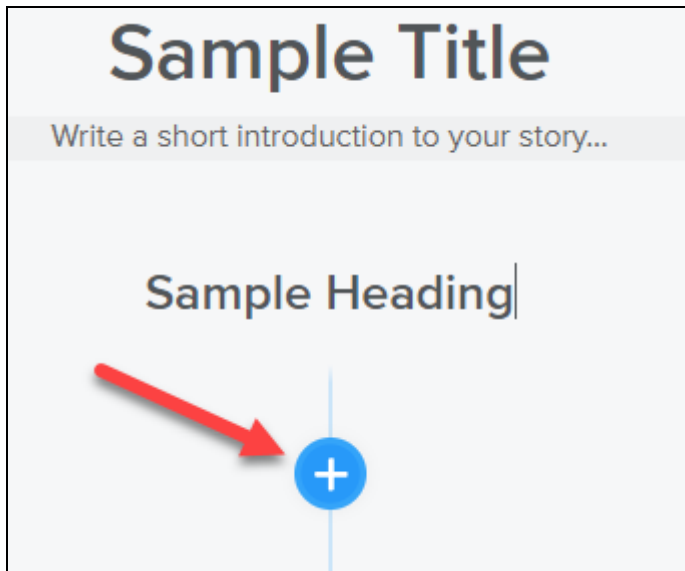


5. Add a banner

1. Click on the colored area under your profile picture. Click the icon and select Edit

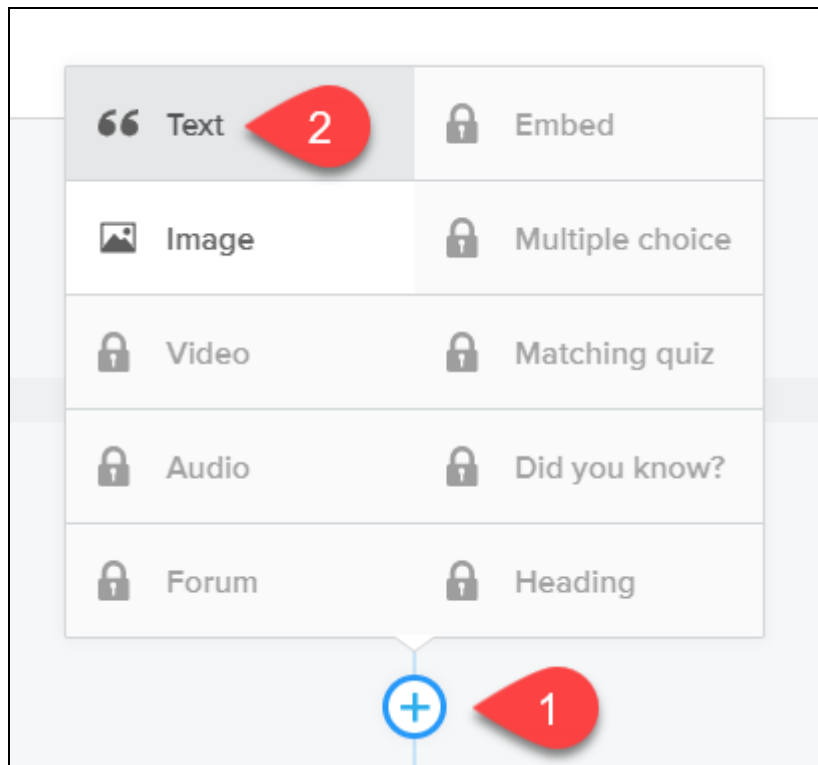


6. On the timeline, mouse-over an area on the timeline and click the  button

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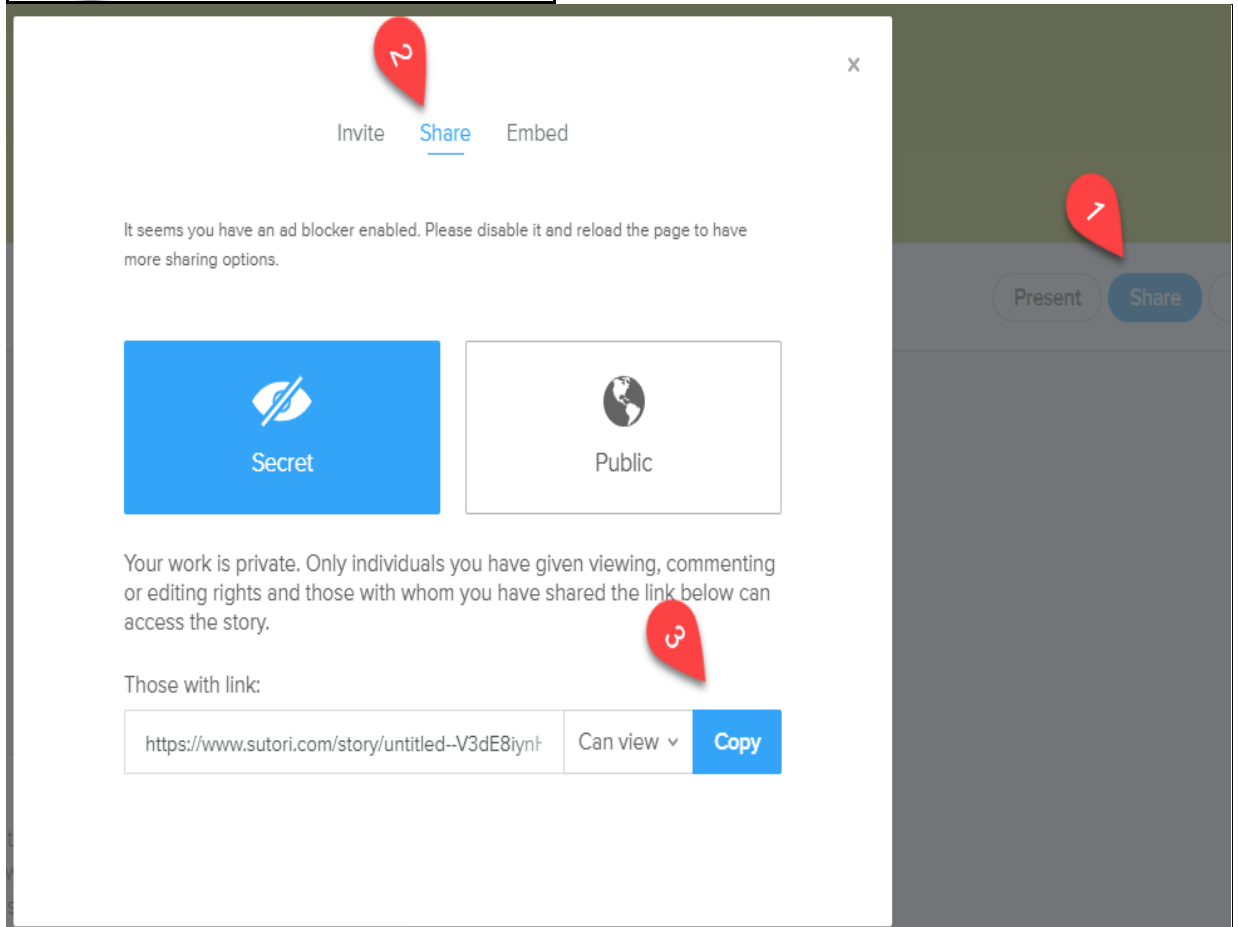
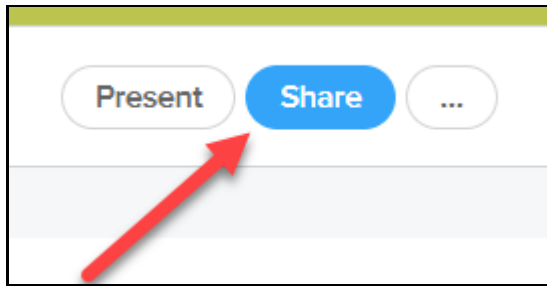
