Regulations

on regional online essay contest "In the dream world"

for high school students, students of colleges and universities.

Department of Kazakh and Russian languages and Department of Foreign languages of D. Serikbaev East Kazakhstan State Technical University within the framework of program "Rukhani Zhangyru "announce a regional online essay contest in Kazakh, Russian and foreign language (optional) on topic: "In the dream world" for high school students, students of colleges and students of universities.

- 1. General Provisions.
- 1.1 The Regulations on the essay contest "In the Dream World" defines aim and objectives of the essay contest and its procedure.
- 1.2 The main purpose of the contest is to develop intellectual and creative potential of participants. Objectives: 1) to form developed and creative personality; to acquire skills of creative thinking and fantasy; 2) to enhance motivation of the participants to achieve high goals, aspirations to the future; 3) to form an active life style and sense of responsibility for their personal choice; 4) to identify and support talented children and gifted youth; 5) to increase the creative potential of youth; 6) develop skills of independent and creative thinking and skills of written presentation in one of the declared languages; 7) to stimulate the independent research activity of schoolchildren, students and students.
- 2. Participants of the contest
- 2.1. Regional online essay contest "In the dream world" is held for high school students, students of colleges and universities.
- 3. Contest procedure
- 3.1. Dates

March 28, 2018 - May 28, 2018.

I step: 28.03.2018. - 28.04.2018.

Every participant of the contest provides a package of documents, which includes:

- the application for participation in the contest (Appendix 1).
- competitive essay.

II step: 29.04.2018. – 17.05.2018

Work of a jury, summing up results of the contest and sending out the results.

- 3.2. Each participant receives an extract from the jury protocol indicating the points received.
- 4. Announcing the contest results and rewarding the winners:
- 4.1. The results of the contest are summed up individually for each participant in accordance with the evaluation criteria.
- 4.2. Winners and prize-winners of the contest are awarded with diplomas (separate for every declared language): Grand Prize 1; for the 1 place 1; for the 2 nd place 1; for the third place 1. Those who did not win prizes receive the certificates of participant, mentors of the winners letters of appreciation. Sample of downloadable online diplomas, certificates, letters of appreciation: www.ziyatker.org → Activity of the Center → Regional Activities → Competition ≪→ next
- 4.3. Contest winners are determined according to the scores earned. Scores are given according to certain criteria. The winner is a participant who scores from 91 to 100 points;

A diploma of the second degree is awarded to a prize-winner, who scores from 81 to 90 points;

A diploma of the third degree is awarded to a prize-winner, who scores from 75 to 80 points.

4.4. The scores are final.

The essays cannot be edited and are not returned to the authors.

- 4.5. At the same time the organizers have a right to publish and use essays in the future work. The best results will be published on the website of D. Serikbayev EKSTU
- 5. Essay assessment criteria:
- content completely corresponds to the specified topic of the contest (up to 10 points)
- -topic is completely focused, content is covered fully (up to 10 points); -
- erudition, awareness of the topic (up to 20 points);

- sequence and originality of presentation (up to 10 points);
- ability to formulate conclusions and argue (up to 10 points);
- -creative and independent thinking (up to 10 points);
- spelling (up to 10 points);
- organization of an essay (up to 10 points).
- 6. Requirements:
- Essay should be submitted in electronic form with up to 3 sheets of A 4 format, Microsoft Office Word program, version 2003-2010; Times New Roman font; 14th size, single spacing.
- -Essay should be in a separate file;
- Title page should contain: topic, first and last name of a participant, group, faculty;
- Essay should be in ONE language: Kazakh', Russian, foreign language;
- Spelling rules.

The contest committee may reject an essay that does not meet the requirements of the contest regulations.
