International scientific and technical conference in honor of the 60th anniversary of D. Serikbayev EKSTU called "The role of universities in creating an innovative economy" will be held in Ust-Kamenogorsk, on September 26, 2018. All meetings of the conference will be organized in the main building of D. Serikbayev East Kazakhstan State University. (Serikbayev str., 19). As part of the conference on September 25, 2018, it is planned to organize a field trip to the AK-Baur ecosite. The cost of the trip is approximately 3000 tenge (600 rubles, 10 dollars, 8 euros) for 1 person. Payment will be made on departure. The duration of the tour is approximately 4 - 4.5 hours.

Fieldtrip to ecosite AK-Baur

One of the most unique cultural monuments of Rudny Altai is the Neolithic temple complex AK-Baur. It is 38 km away from the city of Ust-Kamenogorsk, in the upper reaches of the creek Akbaur, near the village Sagyr, on the mountain Korzhimbay. Here it is possible to observe the unique landscapes of granite massifs and to see petroglyphs on granite rocks and grottoes.

AK-Baur is an open-air temple, strictly oriented to the west, and intended for funeral ceremonies, when the deceased as if repeated all the way to a better world. AK-Baur reminds many other Neolithic temples of England, Britain, Caucasus, Front Asia, and Kazakhstan. Stonehenge was one of the first complexes to be investigated; scientists concluded that the rings of stones were places of religious and other ceremonies, and the rows of stones served as alleys for ritual processions. AK-Baur is also a monument of early culture and is interesting because, unlike many such megalithic constructions, it has a detailed epigraphic support.





One of the most interesting places of AK-Baur is the cognominal grotto. The semicircular space of the grotto is covered with a stone slab with a hole in the shape of a heart. The natural opening of the "roof" of the grotto in the shape of a heart has traces of processing; perhaps it was corrected by a man who made a ledge to fix the movement of the main constellations of the night sky, as well as the moon and the sun.



Among the symbols in the grotto are many different crosses, signs of the Sun. Petroglyphs in the grotto of AK-Baur confirm the scientists' conclusions that there were systematic astronomical observations, and schematic petroglyphs of the Neolithic age points to the origin of pictographic writing.
