



## Charter of the ecological club "Clover"

*Slogan: "Student youth  
for a sustainable future"*

### 1. General provisions

The ecological club "CLOVER" (hereinafter – eco-club) was organized on 01.11.2019.

The Eco club was created for the purpose of conducting educational and research activities, fostering an ecological worldview, and promoting the ideas of sustainable development.

The Eco Club operates at the School of Geosciences (hereinafter referred to as the school) of the East Kazakhstan Technical University (hereinafter referred to as the University), located at 19 Serikbayeva str., Ust-Kamenogorsk.

The Eco Club operates in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the internal regulations and regulatory and methodological documents of the University.

### 2. Main tasks and their implementation

#### *2.1. The main objectives of the eco-club are:*

- expanding and deepening students' knowledge about the environment;
- introducing students to educational and research activities, project and search activities;
- development of civic and social activity of students;
- promotion of a healthy lifestyle;
- acquisition of skills and skills of competent behavior in nature;
- transfer of experience of senior members of the eco-club to younger ones;
- professional orientation within the framework of specialties.

#### *2.2. In order to implement the main tasks, the eco-club has the rights::*

- organize and conduct events;
- publish information leaflets, newsletters;
- conduct research and projects;
- involve university students in ongoing events.

### 3. Main activities:

- educational activities among university students, schools and the population of Ust-Kamenogorsk;
- organization of mass environmental events;
- practical activities for the improvement of your city and its territory (creation of socially significant projects, planting trees, laying flower beds, garbage collection, etc.);

- interaction with other environmental organizations, government agencies, universities.

#### **4. Principles of ecoclub activity:**

- voluntary;
- equality;
- collectivism;
- partnership;
- respect;
- self-government;
- legality;
- strict compliance with the Charter;
- priority of universal values;
- love for the Motherland;
- openness to cooperation.

#### **5. Membership of the eco-club:**

- membership in the eco-club is on a voluntary basis;
- any student or employee of EKTU can become a member of the eco-club;
- membership in the eco-club is carried out without charging membership fees;
- Membership in the eco-club is fixed by the School order.

#### **6. Rights and obligations of Eco club members:**

##### ***6.1 Eco club members have the right to:***

- respect for human dignity, freedom of conscience and information, and free expression of one's own views and beliefs;
- take part in club events;
- make suggestions for the work of the club;
- to cover the activities of the eco-club through media platforms;

##### ***6.2 Eco club members are obliged to:***

- comply with the Charter;
- respect the honor and dignity of other students and employees of the university.

#### **7. Considering the integral GPA in the activities of the eco-club**

The accounting and accrual of the integral GPA is carried out in accordance with the NPJSC EKTU 053-I-2023 "Regulation on the implementation of the integral GPA in the NPJSC "EKTU named after D. SERIKBAYEV" (hereinafter – the Regulation).

According to the Regulation, the main areas of assessment of students' social activities include volunteer and charitable activities of students:

- 1) organization of the work of the volunteer group;
- 2) participation in volunteer actions, events;
- 3) participation in the activities of a volunteer organization on a permanent basis;

4) activities as mentors.

Socio-political activities, including:

1) organization of student associations in various fields (debates, startups, environmental movements, etc.);

2) participation in public events;

3) participation in the activities of a student association, a public association, a party, a social movement.

Cultural, mass and creative activities, including:

1) organization of cultural events of different levels;

2) participation in cultural and creative events of the University, the region, the republic (excursions, visits to theaters, museums);

3) participation in the creative team of the University, performances at cultural events;

4) participation in city, regional, national, and international creative competitions.

Image activity, social media activity:

1) publications in the media, posts on social media pages to create a positive image of the University;

2) publications in the media, posts on social media pages to support the ideas of tolerance, equality, spiritual and moral self-development;

3) publications in the media, posts on social media pages on topical issues of the development of modern Kazakh society and the state.

Within the framework of the ecoclub's activities, it is possible to implement the above activities with the accrual of appropriate GPA points.

According to the Regulations, points are awarded for participation in the activities of the eco-club, as shown in table 1.

## **8. Formation of an eco-club asset**

Students are selected as the ecoclub asset according to the following rules:

- Participation in the ecoclub asset is carried out on a voluntary basis;
- The selection of participants is based on a short summary, the form of which is shown in Appendix A;
- Participation in the asset of the eco-club is fixed by the order of the School;
- The ecoclub's asset is published on the ecoclub's page on the University's website.

#### 9. Ecoclub asset structure:

- Chairman;
- Vice-Chairmen;
- Organizers;
- Responsible for the media activity of the eco-club.

#### 10. Rights and obligations of an eco-club asset

Ecoclub asset members have the right to:

- develop and approve the ecoclub's work plan for the current academic year;

- organize eco-club events;
- to involve students and University staff in events;
- to make proposals for the work of the eco-club, to consider and approve them;
- prepare materials to cover the activities of the eco-club through the University's media platforms;
- \* maintain communication with other clubs of the University and the city;
- \* plan and conduct joint events with other clubs of the University and the city.

The members of the eco club are obliged to:

- comply with the Charter;
- respect the honor and dignity of other members of the eco-club, students and University staff;
- support the initiatives of other ecoclub members to improve its activities;
- coordinate the work plan of the eco-club and proposals for the work of the eco-club with the head of the eco-club.
