

Charter of the ecological club "Eco House"

Slogan: «Let the green heart of nature always beat!»

1. General provisions

1.1 The Ecological club "Eco House" (hereinafter referred to as the eco- club) was organized on 30.08.2022.

1.2 The Eco-Club was created for the purpose of conducting educational and research activities, educating an ecological worldview, and promoting the ideas of sustainable development.

1.3 The Eco-club operates at the Faculty of Humanitarian Education of the East Kazakhstan Technical University, located at the address: Ust-Kamenogorsk, Serikbayev str., 19.

1.4 The Eco-Club operates in accordance with the legislation of the Republic of Kazakhstan and the internal regulations and regulatory and methodological documents of the University.

2. Main tasks and their implementation

2.1. The main tasks of the Ecoclub are:

- development of civil and social activity of students;
- acquisition of skills and abilities of competent behavior in nature;
- transfer of experience of the senior members of the Ecoclub to the younger ones;
- promotion of social activities of students in the field of environmental protection, including through volunteering and environmental events;
- participation in scientific conferences and seminars, conducting scientific research work of students;
- holding round tables, meetings, debates, creative evenings;
- promotion of the club's activities in social networks;
- holding socially significant events in cooperation with environmental organizations.

2.2. To implement the main tasks, the Ecoclub has the rights to:

- organize and conduct events;
- publish information leaflets, bulletins;
- conduct research and projects;
- to involve university students in ongoing activities.
- filming and video filming, editing and releasing films;
- prepare materials for mass media;
- hold exhibitions, meetings, excursions, hikes;
- collect and disseminate publicly significant environmental information;

3. Main activities:

- conservation and study of wildlife
- support for environmental initiatives of the youth of the East Kazakhstan region
- organization of environmental events;

- interaction with other environmental organizations, government agencies, universities.

4. The principles of the ecoclub:

- voluntariness;
- coordination;
- diligence;
- equality;
- collectivism;;
- legality;
- strict observance of the Charter;
- love for nature and the environment

5. Eco club membership:

- Membership in the Ecoclub is on a voluntary basis;
- any student of the EKTU can become a member of the eco-club;
- membership in the ecoclub is carried out without the collection of membership fees;
- Admission to Ecoclub membership is carried out by submitting a written application to the Council of Ecoclub;
- members of the Ecoclub participate in the implementation of the statutory goals and objectives through personal labor, as well as by contributing money or material resources, providing property, services and providing assistance in any other form not prohibited by law.

6. Rights and obligations of ecoclub members:

Ecoclub members have the right to:

participate in the activities of all its bodies, as well as in all ongoing activities;

vote when making decisions;

Discuss any issues related to the activities of the Ecoclub and make proposals for improving its work;

receive information about the activities of the Ecoclub.

Ecoclub members are required to:

be proactive in choosing activities within the organization;

report on their activities;

fulfill the Charter;

respect the honor and dignity of other students and employees of the university;

implement the decisions of the supreme and governing bodies of the Ecoclub;

their actions with the governing bodies of the Ecoclub.
