
# Survey Results "Questionnaire of first-year students" 2022

## The purpose of questionnaire


- To identify the problems of adaptation of first-year students at the university.

- The total number of respondents is 549 people . (out of 760 people).






#### 1. Why did you come to study at EKTU?









# 5. How do you evaluate the information received directly from the staff of the EKTU?






# 6. Did this information help you with choosing a specialty? 2022






# 7. Have you (or your relatives) paid attention to the materials about EKTU published in the media?






#### 8. How do you assess the work of the EKTU Admissions Committee?






## 9. How do you assess the work of the dean's office of your faculty?




## 11. Have you experienced difficulties in adapting to student life?








#### 14. Do you use the university's website and educational platform?






15. Have you found the necessary information on the university's website, in the guidebook?






#### 16. Do you use a guidebook for EKTU students?



2019 - 77,6 %, 2020 - 82,6%, 2022 - 76,68%




#### 17. Do you know the supervisor of your group?

18. How often does the supervisor meet with your group?





#### 19. Are you familiar with the internal Regulations of the university?




### 20. Have you ever address to a supervisor for advice, help, support?






#### 21. Have you received help, support, advice from the supervisor?




## 22. Are you satisfied with the work of the supervisor of your group?


