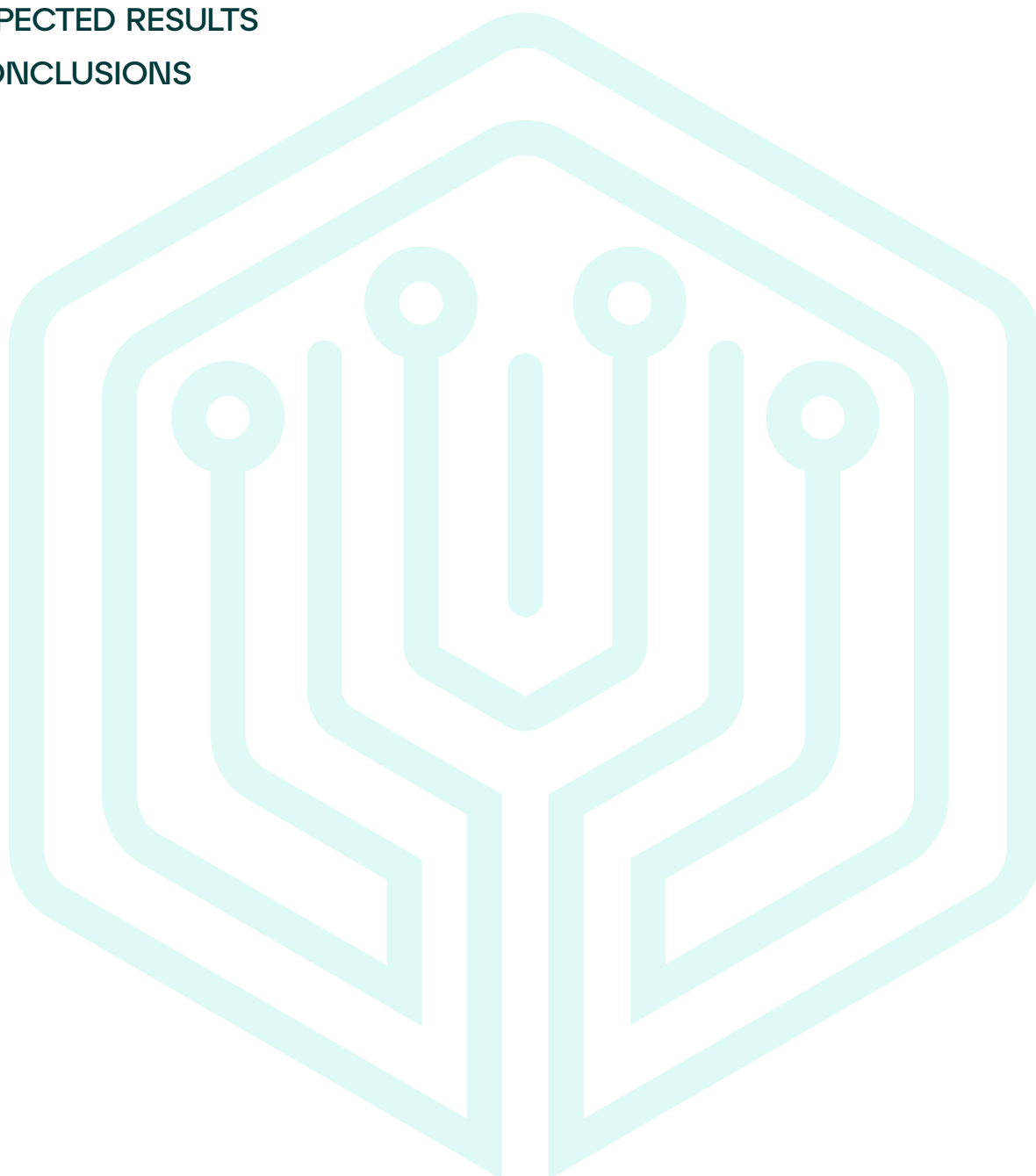

Policy of NJSC «D. Serikbayev EKTU»



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1. GENERAL PROVISIONS

1.1 Goal



The United Nations Sustainable Development Goal No. 16, “Peace, Justice and Strong Institutions,” aims to promote peaceful and inclusive societies, ensure access to justice for all, and build accountable, transparent, and effective institutions at all levels.

D. Serikbayev East Kazakhstan Technical University recognizes that its educational, research, and administrative activities contribute to shaping a culture of justice, trust, and civic responsibility. The university acknowledges its role in strengthening the principles of integrity, transparency, accountability, and the rule of law within the academic environment.

This policy is part of the overall sustainable development strategy of EKTU and is aimed at implementing the principles of ethical governance, openness, and the protection of the rights of all participants in the educational process. The policy applies to all structural divisions of the university, academic staff, administrative personnel, and the student community.

Each unit of EKTU is obliged to ensure that its activities comply with the provisions of this policy and integrate them into the university’s educational, research, and administrative processes.

2. MAIN PRINCIPLES

- 1) Mutually beneficial cooperation — partnerships are built on the principles of equality, respect, trust, and exchange of experience.
- 2) Integration and openness — the results of joint activities are accessible to society, and partnership practices are integrated into educational and research processes.
- 3) Transparency and accountability — all agreements and projects are implemented in compliance with ethical and legal standards, with open reporting on the results.
- 4) Innovation — scientific and technological initiatives aimed at solving sustainable development challenges are encouraged and supported.
- 5) Contribution to regional and global development — partnerships contribute to strengthening human potential, developing infrastructure, and promoting the dissemination of knowledge.

3. MAIN DIRECTIONS OF THE POLICY

1) International and inter-university cooperation

EKTU develops academic ties with foreign and domestic universities and participates in international networks and consortia. Joint educational and research projects are implemented with foreign universities, including cooperation with SeoulTech (South Korea) in the field of engineering education and sustainable development. Academic mobility programs for teachers and students are being expanded. The university actively participates in international grants, forums, and conferences, promoting the experience of Kazakhstani engineering education.

2) Cooperation with industrial and public organizations

EKTU collaborates with regional enterprises to organize internships, practical training, and research and production projects. Jointly with businesses and NGOs, initiatives in environmental, social, and innovative areas are implemented. The university facilitates the introduction of technologies and knowledge necessary for the development of the region and the country.

3) Development of scientific and technological partnerships

Interdisciplinary research centers and laboratories are being established.

The university develops a Competence Center for Ecology and Life Safety, which focuses on environmental research and supports the implementation of the SDGs. Opportunities for technology transfer and the exchange of scientific data between partners are being expanded.

4) Educational and outreach cooperation

The university conducts training sessions, seminars, and lectures on sustainable development, innovation, and international cooperation.

Students and faculty members are involved in volunteer and social initiatives within the framework of the SDGs. EKTU supports participation in international projects, competitions, and startup programs that strengthen academic partnership.

5) Monitoring and improvement of partnership activities

Regular analysis of cooperation effectiveness is carried out, as well as assessment of the contribution of partnerships to the sustainable development of the university and the region.

The university publishes reports on the results of partnership activities, international projects, and achieved indicators.

Based on the analysis, strategies for cooperation are adjusted, and new directions of partnership are expanded.

Formation of EKTU's image as an open, responsible, and globally oriented university.
